About Eileen



*In 1998, Eileen Koff, CPO founded **To The Next Level**, a professional organizing business based on Long Island, New York. Eileen's mission is to help her clients uncover the causes of disorganization and give them the successes they are so desperately seeking.*

Eileen received the industry's distinction as a Certified Professional Organizer (CPO) in the inaugural offering in 2007. She volunteered her service in the National Association of Professional Organizers (NAPO) from 2004-2013 as the education committee's Communication Project Head. She helped develop several NAPO course

offerings, served as NAPO's Newsletter Editor and *NAPO News* Publication Chair. Under her leadership, *NAPO News* won the prestigious APEX award in 2013. Eileen has also earned a level two certification as a member of the Institute for Challenging Disorganization (ICD). In March 2014, Eileen co-developed and presented "*Getting Visible Results in a Virtual World*" workshop to over 135 ICD members.

In 2009, **To The Next Level** became the first company in the professional organizing industry to receive an eco-consultant certification through Green Irene, a New York-based company specializing in promoting eco-friendly awareness. Eileen was the featured eco-speaker at the NAPO 2010 convention in Columbus, Ohio. In January 2013, Eileen was awarded NAPO-LA "Best Green Service" award as the leading eco-organizer in the industry. In April 2013, Eileen spoke as a panelist at the NAPO national convention in New Orleans on the topic of "Stepping into ECO...Environmentally Conscious Organizers."

Eileen has served as Education and Devotion Director for Faithful Organizers (www.faithfulorganizers.com), an online international Christian community of professional organizers since 2007. Since its inception, she has produced a monthly devotion highlighting biblical principles in organizing. From 2011-15, Eileen was a regular columnist for the Christian women's magazine *Just Between Us*, with subscribership at over 8,500. In 2012, Eileen wrote a six-week Bible study called **Organize His Way-A Christ-Centered Approach to Organizing Your Life** which she teaches at local churches. Eileen has been featured in numerous local and national print media and radio/podcast shows.

Her passion is speaking and teaching various groups on the joys of leading an orderly life, but her obsession lies in witnessing the transforming power of God's Word into the lives of those she serves. Eileen and her husband, Wayne, married almost 40 years, have three sons: Ian, Evan, and Keenan. When not organizing, she can be found enjoying the joys of cooking, traveling with her husband across the globe and growing closer to Jesus day by day.


